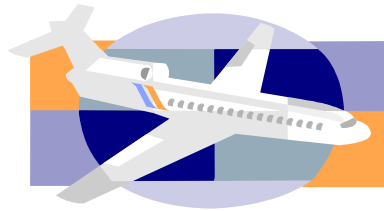


## COLLO's Purpose



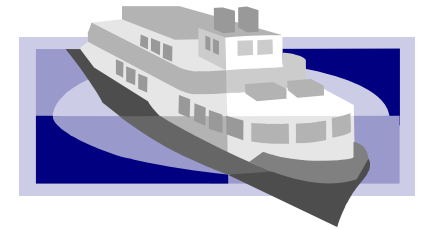

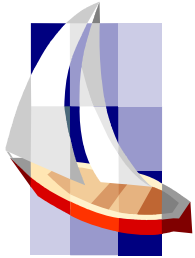
